Award amounts vary, but will not exceed a third of the program charge. If you're awarded a partial scholarship, you must contact us right away to let us know whether or not you'll be accepting the award.

Scholarships are reserved for credit-bearing programs and thus not available for the non-credit Robotics program.

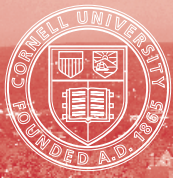
